



Basics of Water Loss Control

In a typical water distribution system a large percentage of water is lost in transit from treatment plants to consumers. Leaks waste both money and a precious natural resource.

This course explores the many ways that leaks and other non-revenue water losses can be reduced or eliminated.

Topics covered during this course include:

- Knowing that water utilities are the largest consumers of electricity
- leaks can cause secondary damage to infrastructure, roads and buildings
- leaks present a public health risk during negative pressure events
- causes of leaks
- leak detection methods
- water audit process
- documentation and record keeping
